We follow the Well Child Visit Schedule recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics. After age 2, we recommend annual appointments with one of our pediatricians through age 18 to assess your child's healthy growth and development.

<b>HiB</b>	Haemophilus Influenzae Type B
<b>IPV</b>	Inactivated Polio Vaccine
<b>Menactra</b>	Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine- Meningococcal Disease
<b>MMR</b>	Measles-Mumps-Rubella (one shot instead of three)
<b>Pentacel</b>	DTaP-IPV-HIB (one shot instead of three)
<b>PCV</b>	Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine - Pneumonia
<b>Quadracel</b>	DTaP-IPV
<b>Rotateq</b>	Rotavirus
<b>Tdap</b>	Tetanus, Diphtheria, Acellular Pertussis
<b>Trumenba</b>	Meningococcal B Vaccine
<b>Bexsero</b>	Meningococcal B Vaccine
<b>Varivax</b>	Varicella (Chicken Pox)
